SYMPOSIUM OVERVIEW

The Utah Clinical and Translational Science Institute (CTSI) Workforce Development Foundation is hosting the 4th Annual Translational Research Trainee Symposium. This full-day retreat will bring together students, staff, and faculty from across the CTSI and University of Utah Health campus:

- Master of Science in Clinical Investigation (MSCI)
- Mentored Career Development <u>KL2</u> Scholar Program
- Spheres of Translational Across the Research Spectrum (STARS) TL1 Program
- MD-PhD Program
- Vice President's Clinical and Translational (<u>VPCAT</u>) Research Scholars

Platform presentations will be delivered by nominated CTSI trainees across all programs. A 3-minute thesis/research competition will allow trainees to share their results in a more concise oral format. For trainees not presenting orally, there will be a poster session. This symposium provides multiple opportunities for networking.

WHO IS REQUIRED TO ATTEND?

All CTSI trainees in participating programs are required to attend all day and present their research in one of the three public formats.

POSTER SESSIONS

Trainees who are not presenting orally are required to present a poster showcasing their research. Each poster presenter should prepare 2-minute talks to highlight their research impact. Posters need to be printed and brought to the poster session on the day of the symposium.

ORAL PRESENTATIONS

Selected trainees will have the opportunity to share their research in a platform presentation. Trainees are allotted 12 minutes for their presentations and 3 minutes for questions.

Trainees may also present 3 minute thesis/research presentations (3MP) in the style of <u>3-minute Thesis</u>. The goal of 3MP is for students to articulate the significance of their research without using jargon, field-specific language, or other language unfamiliar to those outside their fields of study. Only **one** slide may be used for 3MP.
